

Torre Oria Brut Cava NV

Penedes, Spain

This standout sparkler is unusually delicious and really over delivers for its price which is why we had to run it again. 100% Macabeo, it is bone dry with fine bubbles and scents and tastes of lemons, sage and apple. It is absolutely delicious on its own or as the base for a great spring drink like the classic French 75.

Sottal Vinho Branca

Lisboa, Portugal

A blend of Arinto, Vital and Moscatel. Highly perfumed (thanks to the Moscatel) with its light sparkle and off-dry character. It is very light & bright, has lychee spiciness to balance its crisp, fresh fruitiness & is only 9.5% alc..

Roots Pinot Gris 2019

Yamhill-Carlton, Oregon

Bursting with fresh pear, green apple and citrus, the nose is accented by a hint of vanilla. Entry on the palate offers juicy flavors that mirror aromas with the addition of honeydew melon and jasmine tea. With a bright medium-bodied profile, the wine is clean, crisp and refreshing.

Mystery California Chardonnay

Vina Maitia Aupa Pipeno Rose 2021

Maule, Chile

This wine is a blend of 80% Pais and 20% Carignan and is made in an old style called Pipeño. The wine is light in color with bright notes of crushed raspberry, wild strawberry, and rose petals that lead into underlying hints of dried herbs, mint leaves, fennel and thyme. Enjoy with a slight chill.

Monte Seco Vinho Tinto

Minho Portugal

A blend of Touriga Franca Tinto Roriz—Ripe and juicy, the palate on this beautiful red is something to be savored. Flavors of plums and strawberries take the delicious lead. The tannins are soft and provide a balance that makes the finish long-lasting and silky smooth.

Ochoymedio Malbec 2020

Spain

Opaque purple in color with a bright, floral nose of boysenberries. the wine is a youthful, easy-to-drink, food-friendly version of Malbec, showing more in common with Cot from France's Loire valley than the suave Argentine style or tannic model from Cahors.

Gassier Syrah 2018

Costiers de Nimes, France

Pristine blackberry and plum flavors are etched by graphite in this juicy, thirst-quenching Syrah. While full bodied and intensely ripe, it's a crisply concentrated, mineral sip that finishes on fine, softly edged tannins.

Chemins des Bassac Cabernet Sauvignon 2019

Languedoc, France

From its aromas of vibrant red and blue fruit to its silky tannins and balanced acidity, this is a lush and alluring Cabernet Sauvignon. On the palate, rich flavors of raspberry, ripe plum and blueberry carry the wine to a long, luxurious finish, with nuanced hints of oak and sweet baking spices.

Oracle Cellars Labyrinth Red Blend

Mendocino, California

This blend is comprised of Sangiovese, Barbera, and Zinfandel. Grown in volcanic soil and partially aged in new oak, this is a perfect expression of Mendocino's terroir and the resulting concentrated red & blue fruits and silky smooth finish.



Fableist Zinfandel 2019

Central Coast, California

The nose is filled with floral black cherry, rich plums & brown spices. An intensely rich palate loaded with sappy red fruits, clove, pepper & toasty oak. The finish is long, warm & peppery with a lovely mouthfeel & firm tannins.

Laura Hartwig Cabernet Franc 2015

Colchagua Valley, Chile

100% Cab Franc from this small producer minutes from Santa Cruz, Chile. Nose of licorice, black fruit, smoked pepper & herbal notes. The palate shows blackberry, cherry, cola, turned earth & pepper.
